



ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Italian Greyhounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portugese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughi and Whippets, at least one year of age, that have been registered with The American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) may be entered. Breed disqualifications apply. Foundation Stock Service Breeds eligible to compete for suffix titles only are Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Portuguese Podengo (Medio and Grande), and Thai Ridgeback.

STAKES OFFERED

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate OR an ASFA certification certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all hounds, which are eligible to enter the Open or Special Stake and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Field Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may **NOT** be entered.

SINGLES: Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (open, specials or veteran) at the same event. Order of running shall be determined by random draw. Each hound shall run the course alone. Judges shall score a dog's performance the same as a regular stake. Single Stake entries from all breeds shall be combined to determine placements. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/or Best in Field courses. The host club shall award ribbons to placing hounds. Ribbon colors applicable to regular stakes shall apply. No Best of Breed ribbon will be awarded.

TESTS OFFERED

Junior Courser: Open to all eligible sighthounds. A hound running alone must receive a certification from a Judge on one date, and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, with each Judge stating that the hound completed a (minimum) 600-yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption. Ribbons (Dark Green) will be awarded to all hounds that successfully complete the AKC Junior Courser Test.

Qualified Courser: Open to hounds that are at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.

BEST IN FIELD will be offered BOTH DAYS and Limited PRACTICE Saturday ONLY

Conditions of Entry: Hounds must be 1 year of age or older on the day of the trial. A stake will be split if entries are present to make a five point majors in any one stake at the time of the draw. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched. Hound Certification runs will be offered immediately after the trial. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) may be entered. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The course will be reversed for the finals, runoffs and Best of Breed. The members of THLC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the date of the trial. Exhibitors are requested to not bring bitches known to be in season to the field. There will be a \$5.00 fine assessed for any loose hound not participating in the course. Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee. Please bring shade and water. Camping is available, NO HOOKUPS.
