From the North: Take 287 South to Exit 12 for Westin Canal Rd toward Manville/S Bound Brook. Turn left onto Weston Canal Road. Take 3rd left onto Randolph Road. Turn right onto Schoolhouse Rd Turn left onto Mettlers Road. Colonial Park will be on the left.

From the South: Take I-95N to exit 7b to merge onto US 206North/bayard Ln/County Rd 533. Continue to follow 206 North. Turn right onto Amwell Road. Turn left onto Mettlers Road. Park will be on the left.

From the West: Take 78 East to Exit 29 for I-287 toward US202/206/180 Morristown/Somerville. Keep right at the fork to continue toward I-287S. Inspection & Roll Call 8:45 AM for JC and trial entries.

 Inspection will be allowed earlier than posted if inspection team is available. Early Roll Call by appointment. Field committee may have their hounds inspected early.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY:

Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Italian Greyhounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Soughis and Whippets. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC or have been granted an ILP or PAL by the AKC.

FSS Breeds: Effective January 1, 2016: Azawakh, Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande) and Thai Ridgeback 1 year of age or older, that have been recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS), or that have been granted and Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) are eligible to enter lure coursing tests and trial for junior, senior and master courser titles but are not eligible for championship points, and are not eligible to run in Best in Field.

Junior Courser & Qualified Courser Test - Hounds must be one year of age or older. QC Test must be passed prior to a dog being allowed to enter the Open Stake.

STAKES OFFERED:

Singles Stake - Hounds are run by themselves, scored, and placements are then determined on the basis of the score.

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or an ASFA Certification Course certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC..

OPEN VETERAN: Any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements whose age exceeds six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall exceed five years and Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Afghans, Salukis and Whippets whose age shall exceed seven years.

SPECIAL: Open to all eligible sighthounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points will be awarded from this stake. Qualifying scores earned from the special stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

Note: Hounds who have received a disqualification at an AKC trial are ineligible to compete until recertified.

Note: A hound who has received two dismissals at any time is considered disqualified and will need to meet requalification requirements before competing in competition.

RULES & INFORMATION:

All hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications. Altered or neutered hounds may compete. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are NOT eligible to compete. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Muzzles are not required; it is the owner's responsibility to determine if their hound should be muzzled.

Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched.
Spayed or neutered hounds may be entered.
A fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for any returned checks.
There will be a \$5.00 fine for any loose hound on the field that is not part of the course in progress.
Course will be reversed for finals.
Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/IWAGS/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site immediately.

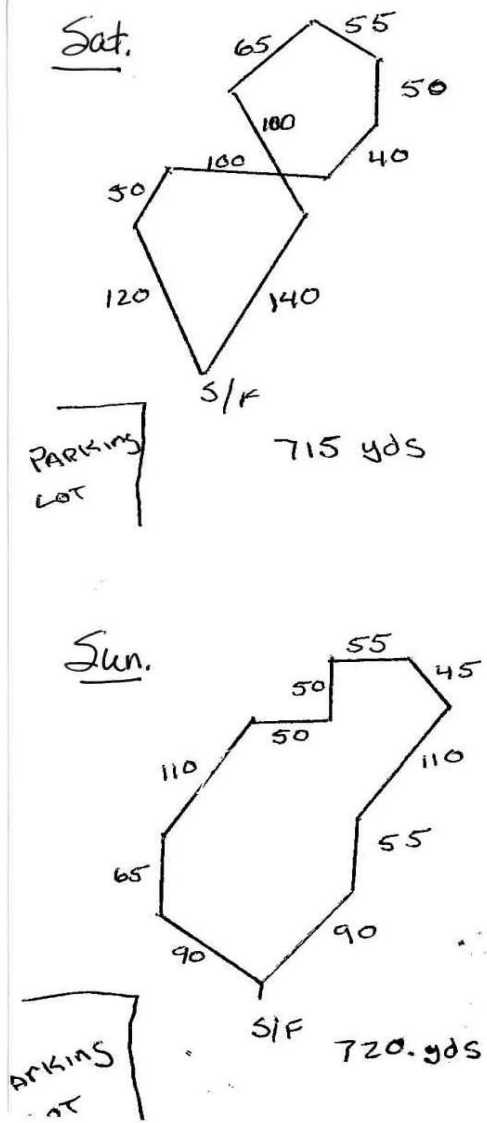

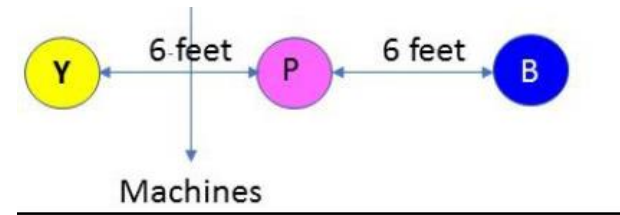

IWAGS COVID Lure Coursing Practices

- No food or drinks will be available at the field. Please plan to bring breakfast and lunch as needed.
- No shade or water will be provided at the field. Please bring your own shade and water to the field
- The Field Trial Secretary will wear a facial covering and gloves while performing duties, to the extent feasible.
- Day of Test/Trial entries will require Owner/Agent to present a check or exact cash for entry fees while wearing gloves. Entrants will be required to bring their own pens or pencils to fill out entry forms, or to fill out checks.
- All attendees/participants are required to follow NJ state and local guidelines [Current NJ Covid Guidelines for Outside Gatherings](#)
- All attendees will practice social distancing.
- All attendees will avoid congregating to the extent possible
- All attendees will avoid touching dogs that are not their responsibility
- All attendees will avoid shaking hands or hugging
- All attendees will practice social distancing while under the pavilion and avoid large gatherings at scoreboard
- All attendees agree to wear their mask to fully cover their mouth and nose
- All Field Committee and Lure Operators will wear facial coverings and gloves while performing duties
- All attendees will wear facial coverings when away from their vehicle, including at the line when releasing dogs
- The Inspection Committee will wear gloves and facial coverings during inspection
- Roll Call will be conducted at the Pavilion with masked owners observing social distancing of 10 feet.
- Owners will be asked to wipe their own females and show the Inspection Committee the used tissue.
- Wickets will be wiped down with disinfectant after each dog is measured.

- Huntmasters will stand a minimum of 6 feet from the hounds after inspecting blankets and slip leads.
- The lures will be tied onto the string no less than 10 feet apart to reduce congestion during the retrieval of hounds.
- At the starting line, hounds will stand in front of the coordinating color frisbees as follows - Yellow Blanket (left of the line), Pink Blanket (right of the line), and Blue (approx. 6 feet from Pink on right side of line)



- At the starting line, hounds will stand a minimum of six feet apart from each other.
- Hand washing stations and/or instant hand sanitizer and/or wet wipes will be made available.
- All attendees agree to leave the Porta John doors propped open when not in use.
- Running Orders will be posted as usual.
- Please use phone camera to take picture of running orders, blanket colors and scoring when possible to avoid large groups gathering at the board
- No self-serve ribbons will be available due to potential cross contamination.
