THE VERSATILITY AWARDS

The Versatility Trophy honors the dog who epitomizes the range of attributes and abilities embodied in the whippet. It is awarded to the whippet with the best average score for the event – consisting of the AKC field trial, both of the race meets-WRA straight race and NOTRA U-val race and a minimum of one of the two matches (obedience or conformation). An exhibitor may enter both matches, and the higher score will be counted. For Versatility conformation scoring, dogs and bitches will be judged in a single class separated by sex. An overall winner will be chosen. Each event will provide competitor with a score from 0 to 10. This individual score is calculated using the whippet's placement in the event and the number of whippets it competes against. At the conclusion of the last event, an overall average of the events entered is computed which determines the most versatile whippet. The first place whippet will have its name added to the perpetual trophy to stand with the other winners from each preceding year. Trophies and ribbons are also awarded to many other whippets who give their all, but don't quite make it. The whippet that completes the event, but finishes last will be honored with the Versatility Turtle and the Perpetual Turtle trophy. Remember, in this competition the winner may not be the best at any one event, but must excel at all events to be this year's Versatility winner. Decisions by the Field Committee, consisting of the secretaries for each event and the event coordinator, are final. Such disputes and protests that may arise concerning the Versatility Award will be resolved by the above mentioned committee before the conclusion of the event. No disputes or protests will be considered more than 1 hour after announcing the Versatility awards

Ribbons and Trophies: 1st - blue, 2nd - red, 3rd - yellow, 4th - white, 5th - pink, BOB - purple and gold. Trophies donated by the JRRWA and Friends will be awarded for BOB and for 1st through 5th in each stake of Whippets.

Only purebred Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club, or an AKC recognized foreign registry, or have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) may be entered. Breed disqualifications will apply.

Stakes Offered

OPEN STAKE (trial) Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

SPECIALS STAKE (trial) Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

OPEN VETERAN STAKE (trial) Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years, and Whippets = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

Best of Breed will be offered

- All entries must be one year old on the day of the trial.
- All hounds will be run twice in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused.
- Hounds not present at time of roll call will be scratched.
- Battery powered continuous loop system will be used.
- Lure will consist of plastic strips.
- Muzzles are not required but are allowed.
- Spayed or neutered hounds may enter.
- All hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications.
- Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds may NOT be entered.
- A \$5 fine will be charged to the owner or handler of any hound loose on the field not competing in the course in progress.
- Course will be reversed for finals, run-offs, and BOB.
- The field is not fenced.
